

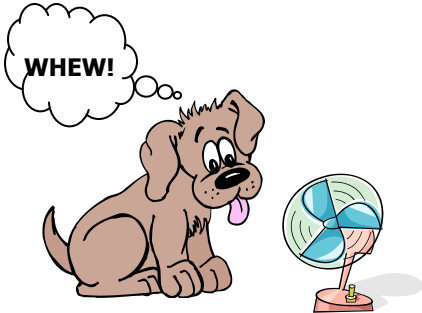

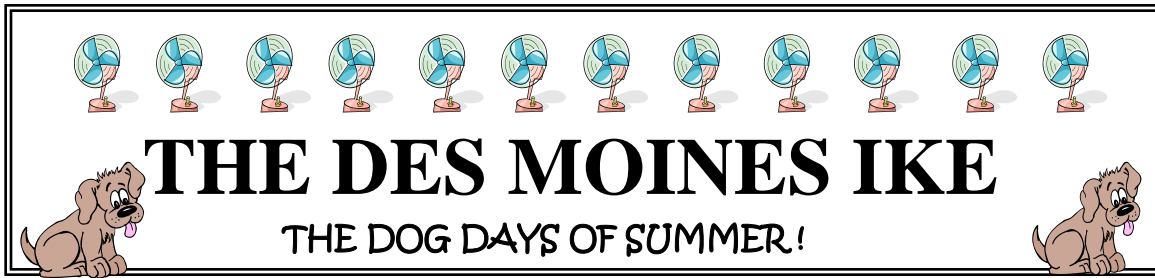

Some natural events are triggered by ground and water temperature while others are harder to understand. If there is an interest among you Ikes, I will write notes for our newsletter, reminiscent of Mark Trail's column that I read in the newspaper when I was a kid. (Tom Holm, a long time member of the Des Moines Ikes, has encouraged me to do so. Tom was the one that got me involved in the Ikes in the first place. I've taken a lot of advice from Tom over the past few years, so I thought I would give it a try) Following is the inaugural "Note from Mark Trail": "This is the time of year you may see a moth, called a Sphinx moth, visiting Hostas and other flowers at dusk that is often mistaken for a Hummingbird.
